Council are asked to approve one year term extensions for Sue Rogers and Mervyn Thomas and note the transition arrangements.

2. Summary

Members of the Nomination & Remuneration Committee (NRC) undertook interviews on 24th September 2015 to determine which two of three incumbent non-executive directors would be offered one year extensions to their terms as previously agreed by the Council of Governors at its meeting of 30th April (CoG 37/8a). Following a robust interview, which was held in accordance with Trust recruitment and selection policies, and noting the annual performance appraisal of each individual, the panel agreed that one year extensions should be offered to Sue Rogers and Mervyn Thomas. The Council of Governors is asked to approve this.

The NRC did however express concern about transitioning arrangements and following further consideration of the issues raised and after access to legal advice, the Trust will offer Tony Clayton a six month contract for services on a consultancy basis in order to allow the newly appointed Non-Executive Director whose term of office begins on 1st December 2015 access to support and handover in a number of areas, but specifically in relation to his function as chair of the Finance and Investment Committee. This has been agreed by the Chief Executive.

3. Next Steps

Mervyn Thomas and Sue Rogers will have theirs terms of office extended by one year, ending on 30th November 2016.

4. Required Actions

The Council of Governors is asked to approve the NED extensions and note the transition arrangements put in place by the Trust.

5. Monitoring Arrangements

Non-executive director appointments are reviewed and led by the Nomination and Remuneration Committee on behalf of the Council of Governors.
