Sheffield Dementia Involvement Group (SHINDIG) is a well-established group of people with dementia and family carers who meet to share experiences and ideas on health and social care services. The group is run by Sheffield Health and Social Care NHS FT and Alzheimer's Society Sheffield.

A small amount of funding from Clinical Research Network – Yorkshire and Humber means that we can support people with dementia from SHINDIG (and beyond) to share their ideas on research topics, proposals and bids between now and the end of March 2015.
